Key Events in South Korea after Korean War

- National Liberation from Japan (광복, August 15, 1945)
- Japanese Colonization Period (일제강점기, 1910 1945)
- Korean War (한국전쟁, 1950-1953)
- April Revolution or April 19 Movement (4 월 혁명, popular uprising in April 1960, led by labor and student groups, which overthrew the autocratic First Republic of South Korea under Syngman Rhee)
- Treaty on Basic Relations between Japan and the Republic of Korea (한일기본조약, June 22, 1965)
- October Yushin (유신 체제, Fourth Republic of South Korea in which President Park Chung-hee assumed dictatorial powers in October 1972)
- Assassination of Park Chung-hee (10. 26 사태, October 26, 1979)
- Gwangju Uprising, May 18 Democratic Uprising or Gwangju Massacre (5.18 광주민주화항쟁, May 18, 1980)
- Torture and death of Park Jong-chul, Seoul National University student (박종철고문치사 사건, January, 1987)
- June Democratic Uprising or June Democracy Movement (6 월 항쟁, nationwide democracy movement during June 10-29, 1987)
- Direct presidential election (직접선거, 1988)
- The 1988 Summer Olympic (88 올림픽, September 17 October 2, 1988 in Korea)
