Del Bontà for a trip to New Orleans, where we will have the rare opportunity to see Asian treasures at New Orleans Museum of Art and in private hands. We will also spend a half day at The National World War II Museum and take a walking tour of the Garden District.

**OPTIONAL ON YOUR OWN:** Consider enjoying Sunday jazz brunch at the legendary Commander's Palace; or add an extra day to visit the Whitney Plantation Museum, the only museum in Louisiana with an exclusive focus on the lives of enslaved people.

## DAY 1: Wednesday, March 23rd

• Bienvenue to NOLA! Arrive at Louis Armstrong International Airport, and transfer to the hotel independently.

• Check in to **International House**, a boutique hotel located two blocks from the French Quarter and Bourbon Street in a beaux-arts building with interiors that combine a modish Big Easy flavor with stylish minimalism. *Check-in time: 4 p.m.* <u>https://www.ihhotel.com/</u>

Specially Reserved for SAA members:

Standard rooms with high ceilings and a choice of one King or two Double Beds (averaging 325-375 sq. ft.), and a mini-fridge. Large granite-and-marble bathrooms are equipped with hair dryers and robes. Room service is not offered, and rooms do not have a minisafe (though guests may use the safe at Reception). There is a small but well-equipped gym. WiFi is free of charge.

- Evening wine & cheese at the hotel in a private gallery space, and introductory talk by our scholar, **Robert J. Del Bontà**.
- Dinner on your own. A List of Suggested Restaurants will be provided.

### DAY 2: Thursday, March 24th

• Continental Breakfast is included daily. Vouchers will be provided at check-in.

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- Morning self-guided visit at The National WWII Museum.
- Lunch on your own at one of two restaurants in the WWII Museum
- Afternoon tours with **Robert J. Del Bontà** at the **New Orleans Museum of Art (NOMA)** of the special exhibitions, "*The Pursuit of Salvation: Jain Art from India*" and "*Arte Sacra: Roman Catholic Art from Portuguese India*."
- Dinner on your own.

## DAY 3: Friday, March 25th

- Morning docent-led tour at the NOMA of "Queen Nefertari's Egypt" exhibition.
- Lunch on your own at Café NOMA
- Afternoon visit at the **private collection of Gitter/Yelen** to see Edo-era paintings.
- Dinner on your own.

### DAY 4: Saturday, March 26th

- Morning guided walking tour of the Garden District with a local architectural historian.
- Lunch on your own at nearby eateries. Suggestions will be provided by your guide.
- Afternoon visit at the private collection of Dr. Siddharth Bhansali.
- Final dinner at Antoine's, renowned for French-Creole classics served in an elegant setting.

### DAY 5: Sunday, March 27th

Au revoir to NOLA! The tour officially ends. Participants arrange their own travel including airport transfers.
