

ARTful Korea! Contemporary Art Tour 2022

October 22 - November 2, 2022





This tour will be led by former Asian Art Museum Department Head and Associate Curator of Korean Art, Hyonjeong (HJ) Kim Han, who is now the Department Head and Joseph de Heer Curator of Asian Art at Denver Art Museum. ARTful Korea was specifically designed for Society for Asian Art (SAA) members. Tour participants will enjoy visits to the National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art (MMCA), Seoul and Cheongju, Leeum as well as other important contemporary art institutions that have drawn much acclaim from the international contemporary art scene. The tour focuses will be on institutions of contemporary art as well as studio visits and rare and special access granted specifically for SAA members. There will be ample opportunities to soak in the old and new of Korean culture walking through the royal palaces, neighborhoods of traditional houses and antique districts as well as lively openair markets. The tour will continue with a flight to the unique Jeju Island to explore the vibrant contemporary art scene on the island. ARTful Korea! Contemporary Art Tour 2022 will conclude with a flight to Incheon Airport for a farewell dinner and art tour of Paradise City Hotel contemporary art collection.

6 nights in Seoul, Proposed Galleries and Museums (to be confirmed)

- Contemporary art museums, galleries and studio visits in and around the capital of Seoul while enjoying disparate cuisine that is now globally popular. This will be a wonderful introduction to Korea through exploration of contemporary art.
- Some of the exciting venues will include the visit to the Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art (MMCA) Seoul, MMCA Cheongju, Leeum, Samsung Museum of Art as well as Amore Pacific Museum of Art and many other spaces with special access granted to SAA Members
- Artists' studio visits will include a visit to Ms. Yun Suknam who is in her 80s. She has exhibited extensively
 all over the world with work that resonate especially with women, as well as to the studio of Lee Dong-sik,
 a renown ceramic artist whose Moon Jars have earned him much praise. Yang Byeongyong is an artist
 who re-interprets wooden objects that harks back to sublimely minimal and beautiful works of traditional
 artform.

3 nights in Jeju Island, Proposed Galleries and Museums (to be confirmed)

• Jeju island has in recent years become known for fabulous architecture featuring contemporary art. Bonte Museum and Genius Loci are two museums designed by celebrated architect Tadao Ando capturing the essence of Jeju's landscape. Bangju Church-designed by Korean-Japanese Architect Itami Jun, is inspired by Noah's Ark from the Bible. Kim Tchang-yeol is a world-famous artist and this museum shows his collection. If time allows, the group will visit Jeju open market and art galleries such as Jungsan Nongwon and Arario Jeju.

Incheon (last night)

Paradise Art Space at Paradise City Hotel was named one of the top 200 collections in the world according
to recent ARTNews magazine. Famous contemporary artworks of both Korean and other leading notable
artists from around the world are featured within the hotel complex including Jeff Koons, Damien Hirst, as
well as Lee Bae and Kim Hodeuk, Subodh Gupta, Anish Kapoor, Yayoi Kusama, Alessandro Mendini.

- Millennium Hilton Seoul or Sommerset Palace, Paradise Hotel
