

ASIAN ART IN CHICAGO: Museums and Private Collections September 9 - 13, 2013



Join us for five days in Chicago filled with museum tours and private collection visits but still leaving you time to explore this "toddling town" on your own.

Three Museums

- We will visit the Chicago Art Institute with its distinguished Asian collection containing over 35,000 objects of great archaeological and artistic significance. Leading us through this collection will be Madhuvanti Ghose (Alsdorf Associate Curator of Indian and Islamic Art at the Art Institute of Chicago). She also led two spectacular trips for the Society for Asian Art the Silk Road Trip in China, 2006, and the Silk Road Trip to the 'Stans' in 2009.
- On the University of Chicago campus, we will tour the Oriental Institute Museum with Egyptologist Emily Teeter. The museum is a world renowned showcase for the history, art and archeology of the ancient near east.
- We will also stop in at the Smart Museum of Art, the art museum of the University of Chicago, whose Asian collection focuses on the traditional arts of scroll painting and ceramics from China, Japan and Korea.

Three Private Collections

- Margo Pritzker will share with us the acclaimed art that she and her husband, Tom, have collected. Considered one of the foremost collections of South Asian art, it also reflects Tom Pritzker's passion for Himalayan culture.
- Barry MacLean's collection is housed in a private museum on the outskirts of Chicago in Libertyville. Richard Pegg, curator of the collection, will guide us through the Southeast Asian art pieces that come from the areas of Myanmar (Burma), Thailand, Laos, Vietnam, Cambodia and Indonesia. The objects represent a variety of cultures including BanChiang, Dongson, Dvaravati, Cham, Khmer and others.
- One other private collection to be announced.

And Finally.....

• An architectural boat trip on the Chicago River where you'll see dozens of landmark buildings by famous architects as well as hear the story of Chicago's rise from the great fire of 1871 to become home of the skyscraper.
