Main objects (in order of appearance)

Mausoleum Diagram (兆域圖 Zhaoyu tu), c. 310 BCE, excavated from Zhongshan tomb 1 located in Sanji, Pingshan County, Hebei Province. Bronze with gold and silver inlay, 48 x 96 x 0.7-1.2 cm.

Garrison Diagram (駐軍圖 Zhujun tu), Western Han dynasty (206 BCE-9 CE), excavated from tomb 3 at Mawangdui, Changsha, Hunan Province. Ink and pigment on silk, 98 x 78 cm.

Topography Diagram (地形圖 Dixing tu), Western Han dynasty (206 BCE-9 CE), excavated from Mawangdui tomb 3. Ink and pigment on silk, 96 x 96 cm.
